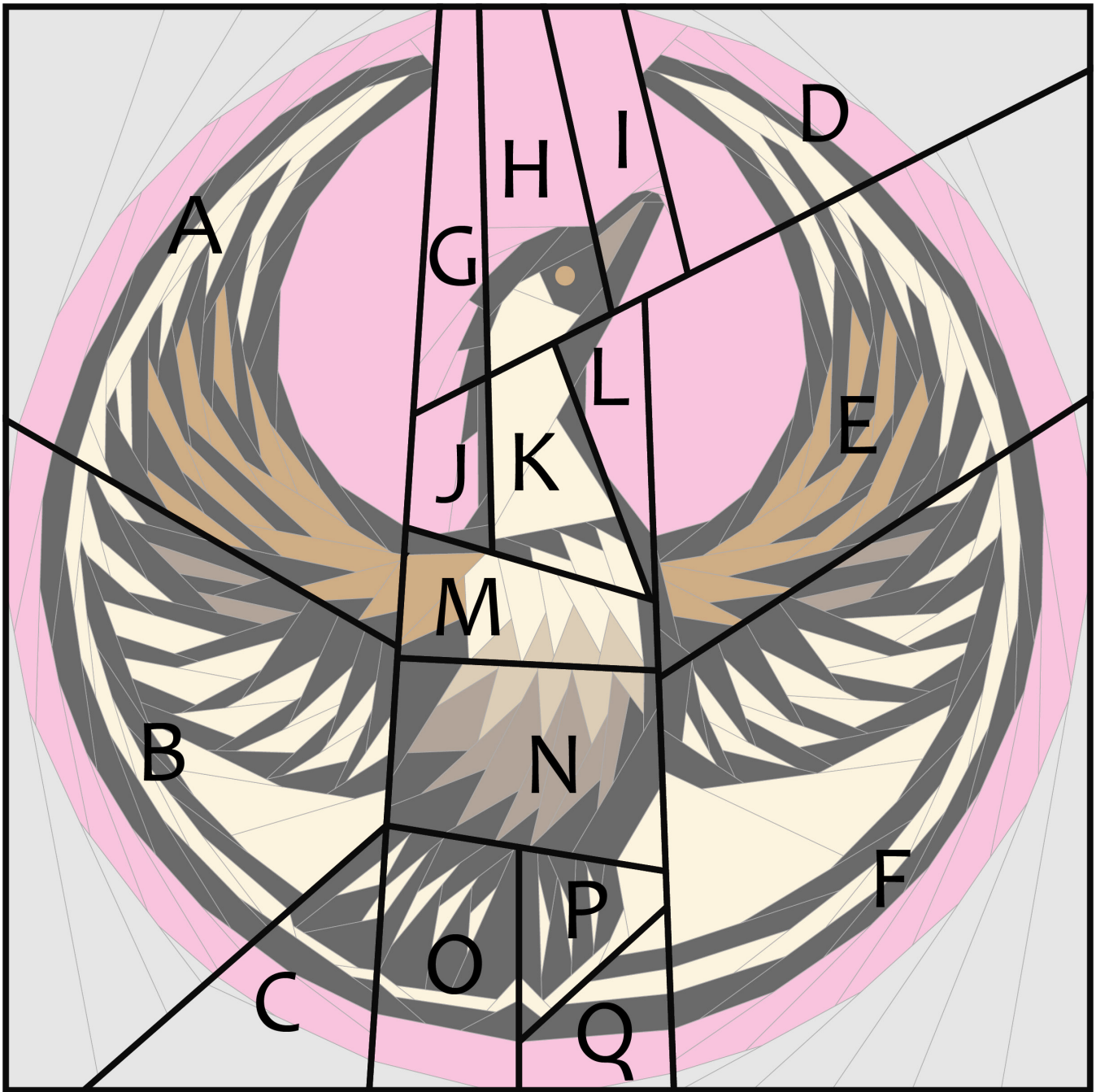
Recommendations:

- **Since this design has many small pieces to accommodate the bird's details, batik or thinner fabric is recommended for best results.**
- This pattern assumes you already have knowledge of FPP and have completed beginning or intermediate designs.
- Color Guides are on page 2, print in color if able.
 - Cut small swatches of the fabric you will be using for each color code and paste them next to the corresponding square in the Color Guide grids.
 - Keep grid close to your cutting and sewing table as a legend and a reminder of which fabric is used for each color code.
 - The final page of the pattern is a grayscale and outline of the pattern, feel free to print and audition different color schemes according to your preference.
- Print the pattern pieces on newsprint paper if available for easy paper removal.
- Sew straight stitch with stitch length 1.5 - 2.0.
- Use an 80 wt or thinner thread for piecing to help keep seam bulk at minimum.
- In more complex areas with small pieces, consider trimming to 1/8" seam allowance.
- Remove paper backing from seam allowance before ironing when piecing separate sections together, this will help reduce bulk from sections pieced together and make final paper removal easier.
- Instructions and videos with helpful hints how to successfully line up and piece together cross seams across blocks are on my website coffeetownquilting.com.
- Once pieced, remove paper, spray liberally with ironing starch, and press well before adding border and quilting.
- The bird's eye can be added afterward using applique, beads, embroidery, or fabric paint.
